
#### **Good and Bad Foods**

#### **Festivals around China**

In our country, people celebrate special days in different ways.

#### Water-splashing Festival (泼水节)

The Water-splashing Festival is the New Year in the Dai calendar. It usually takes place in mid April, and lasts three to



seven days. People dress up in traditional clothes and splash water on anyone passing by. The more you get splashed, the more good luck you will have in the new year.

#### **Tibetan New Year**

The Tibetan people celebrate the Tibetan New Year over a period of two weeks, usually during the months of December and January. According to the Tibetan calendar, the New Year lasts from the first day of the first month to the fifteenth day of the first month. The first three days are the most important.

On the first day, Tibetans get up early, take a bath and put on new clothes. They stay at home to pray (祈祷) and celebrate. On the second day, people visit relatives and friends. On the third

day, each Tibetan family puts up a prayer flag that will fly on their rooftop for the whole year.





#### Third Month Fair

For the Bai people, the Third Month Fair is their most important festival. They celebrate it every year during the third month of the

Chinese calendar, from 15th to 20th of the month. The Bai people hold the festival to pray for a good harvest. There are dances, shows, sports, and horse races during the festival.





In the world, many people have cars and use them every day. We call this private transportation. Buses, trains, boats, and planes are public transportation.

On Land

There are cars, motorcycles, trucks, and buses on the road. Trains run on tracks.



Double deckers are like two buses put together. They can take more people around the city.

A motorcycle is small and fast. Bicycles are the world's most popular means of transportation. There are more bicycle riders in China and the Netherlands (荷兰) than in other countries.

Bullet trains travel very fast. They can move at the speed of 300 km an hour.



#### In the Air

The quickest way to travel a long distance is to fly.

Helicopters can take off and land without a runway. They can stay still (静止的) in the sky. This makes them useful for different



kinds of jobs like fire fighting and sea rescue.

A big jumbo jet carries more than 500 people. The Airbus 380 is the largest plane in the world. It can carry 840 people.



### Symbols (象征物) of Halloween

The pumpkin is a symbol of Halloween. People take out the inside of the pumpkin, carve a face into its side, and put a candle inside to make a lantern. It's called a jack-o'lantern, from a story about a man called Jack who made a deal with the devil (魔鬼).





Black cats, frogs, mice, and spiders are Halloween animals. Most children's favourite animal is the Vampire Bat (吸 血蝙蝠). They are high on the Halloween list.

# **STORY 4**

### **Halloween Celebrations**

Halloween celebrations start in October at every elementary school. Children make all kinds of orange-coloured paper jacko'-lanterns. From black paper they cut out witches riding on broomsticks, or black bats flying across the moon.
