Children play with fireworks for the festival. The fireworks are beautiful. Children like them very much. They get "lucky money" from their parents and grandparents.


On the first day of the Spring Festival, people often get up early. They go from door to door and say "Happy New Year". After that, they visit their friends.

本册呈现18个二级基本词、19个拓展词,重点复现了there be结构、一般过去时和现在进行时,以方位、节日与文化、生活健康等话题训练学生的语言运用能力。每课专设"Check and tick"栏目作为本课语言学习的重点提示。
