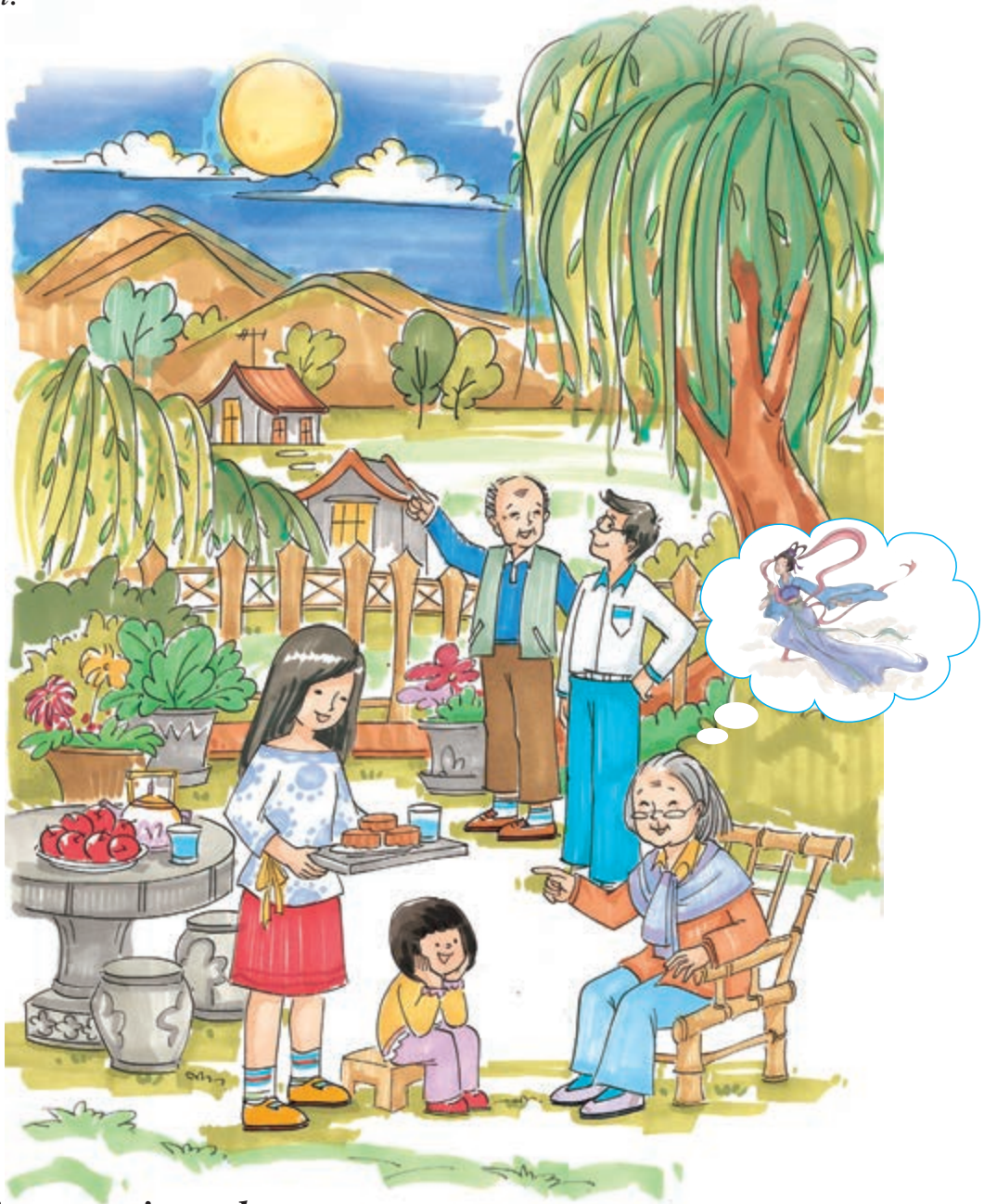

On the first day of the Spring Festival, people often get up early. They go from door to door and say “Happy New Year”. After that, they visit their friends.

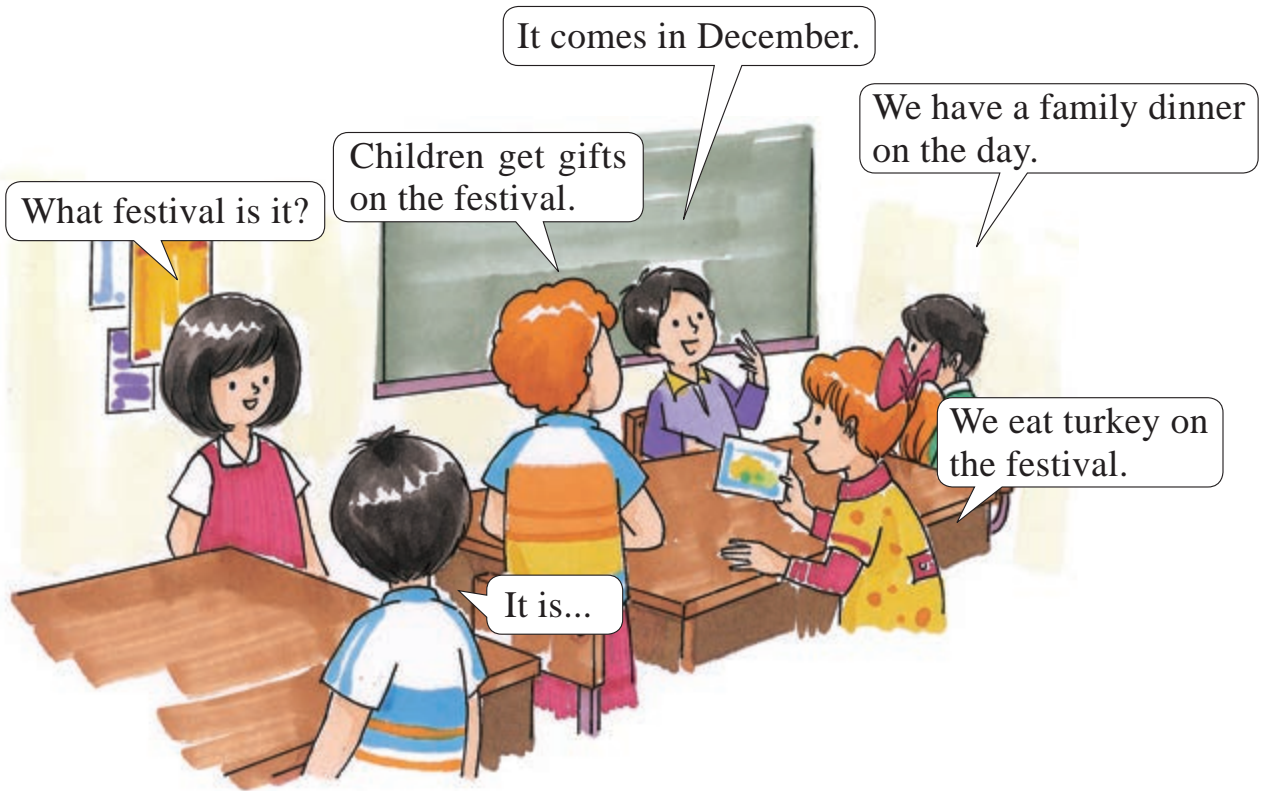
