The Mid-Autumn Festival is an important holiday in the Chinese calendar. Families and friends get together to enjoy the full moon and eat moon cakes. Shops often display pictures of Chang'e flying to the moon.

The Dragon Boat Festival is another traditional Chinese festival. People often remember the Chinese poet Qu Yuan on this day. Qu Yuan loved his people very much when he was alive. After he died in the river, people were very sad. They decided to throw food into the river to feed the fish, so the fish would not eat his body. People also tried to scare the fish away with the dragon-head boats. Today, we eat *zongzi* and race dragon boats to remember this man — Qu Yuan.
